

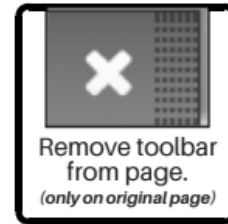
Using Scribe



- Go to **scribe.com**
- Create a free Scribe account using your RB Gmail address.
- Download the Scribe Chrome extension.
- Click on the extension to save articles and web pages to your library.
- After saving an article to your account, the tool bars (shown to the right and below) load onto the screen.
